Dear Adam Mazzocchi,

Thank you for submitting your paper to JAIR. However, I regret to inform you that the paper does not meet our submission requirements. JAIR's Editorial Charter (available at <https://jair.org/index.php/jair/about>) states:

"The Journal of Artificial Intelligence Research (JAIR) is dedicated to the rapid dissemination of important research results to the global artificial intelligence (AI) community." Your paper reads a position paper. While it outlines a distinct vision, it does not evaluate it for plausibility or implementability, and does not discuss the associated challenges (e.g., whether it is possible to design an ethics policy layer that allows for continuous verification and is compatible with usability while capturing important intuitions regarding what constitutes acceptable behavior). As such, the paper is not a research paper, and therefore is not suitable for JAIR (including the AI&Society track).

Please note that this letter should not be taken as a statement regarding the quality of your research. The paper has not been reviewed. This letter is based on an editorial decision that the submission does not meet the requirements for JAIR.

We thank you for your efforts in preparing this submission, and hope that you will find an appropriate forum for this work.
