



# Plataforma Global

## Foundation Summary

Plataforma Global is a non-profit organisation dedicated to social reflection and intervention, positioning itself as an intermediary of ideas and moderator of debate amongst different interlocutors in civil society.

### Mission and Principles

**.PG** promotes solutions to social challenges through dialogue and participation of diverse actors, maintaining strict neutrality and impartiality. It does not advocate actions that do not serve the common good in a plural manner, and its members commit not to hold positions that would compromise this neutrality.

### Operating Model

The organisation develops two main strands:

- **Social Debate:** Organises conferences, observatories and debates with speakers and strategic audiences
- **Social Interventions:** Structures solutions for identified problems, leading conceptually whilst transferring execution to partners from the public, social or private sectors

### Membership

It brings together professionals of recognised excellence who voluntarily offer their time and knowledge in service of the common good. Admission requires good moral and social standing, with conduct that reflects the organisation's principles.

### Sustainability

**.PG** operates without permanent structural costs. Activities are financed ad hoc by the internal patron who proposes them, individually or in association with other members who choose to join the funding, each member covers their personal expenses, and only the secretariat constitutes a remunerated element.

### Institutional Identity

The organisation rejects conventional categorisations, ensuring institutional autonomy and intersectoral vocation, without affiliation to the subsectoral categories in which charities, NGOs and institutions of mercy are placed. The .PG situates itself within the foundational context of the third sector, deriving from the simple association of citizens. It operates through horizontal integration and shared responsibility, sustaining transparency through the reputation and integrity of its members.
