Articles of Organization

Filed pursuant to W.S. 17-31-104 (DAO Supplement to the Wyoming LLC Act)

1. Name of DAO

The name of the limited liability company is: Consolidate Protocol DAO LLC

2. Statement of DAO Status

This company is a Decentralized Autonomous Organization (DAO) as defined by the Wyoming DAO Supplement. This designation is made pursuant to W.S. 17-31-104.

3. Management Structure

This DAO shall be managed by its members. The management by the members shall be conducted as follows: Governance is exercised via token-weighted voting using the CONP token, with smart contract execution of decisions. The specific mechanisms for proposal submission, voting, and execution are detailed in the governing smart contracts and the Operating Agreement.
